

Newfoundland and Labrador's Offshore: Optimizing our Potential, Preparing for the Future

On Thursday December 7, 2023, join Paul Barnes, Director - Atlantic Canada and Arctic, for the Canadian Association of Petroleum Producers (CAPP) on ZOOM as he presents Newfoundland and Labrador's Offshore: optimizing our potential, preparing for the future.



Paul will discuss the Newfoundland and Labrador offshore oil and gas industry's significant potential as a secure and responsible energy producer, as well as how the industry is preparing for the future as the world seeks lower carbon energy sources. He will provide an overview of current activity offshore NL, as well as changes in the regulatory regime surrounding energy. He will also discuss what is needed to ensure the offshore industry remains competitive for investment in the global energy market.

PAUL BARNES is Director - Atlantic Canada and Arctic, for the Canadian Association of Petroleum Producers (CAPP) based in their St. John's, Newfoundland and Labrador office. Paul has over 33 years of experience in the oil and gas industry. Prior to joining CAPP, he was employed with the Canada-Newfoundland & Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board (C-NLOPB) in their Lands Administration and Industrial Benefits departments. He currently serves on several Industry Boards and Committees and is a Director on One Ocean and on the University of Manitoba's Centre for Marine Observation.
